1968 saw the advent of the weekly Chocolate and Chook Wheels at Yeronga Shopping Village to supplement Club funds. Jack Weber was the organiser of this venture. Jack owned the Picture Theatre and lived nearby and was known to all in the area. As the Club had delved into the Fund set aside for the Club House building and Trophy Nights were rather expensive items, it was found necessary to form a Ladies' Social Committee which ran functions during the "Off Season" to give the Club a good start when the new Season commenced. Mrs. June Steinback lead a group of very active and dedicated ladies whose efforts helped greatly in the fund raising field.

Club membership dropped to ninety-nine (99) members. It was not an easy period. Seven Interclub swims were on the programme for the Season and the swimmer of the year (other than Club ) was Ken SIMPKINS who competed in Breastroke in B.A.S.A. and Q.A.S.A. Competitions with some degree of success.
