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## Ted Curtis Corner

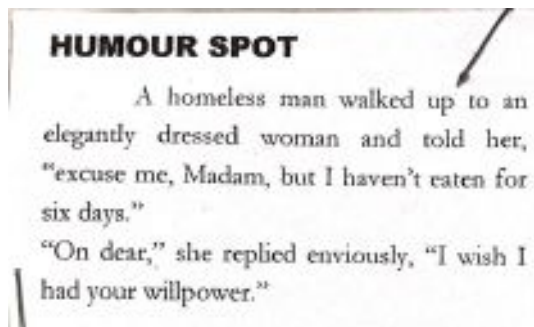
Good evening everyone.

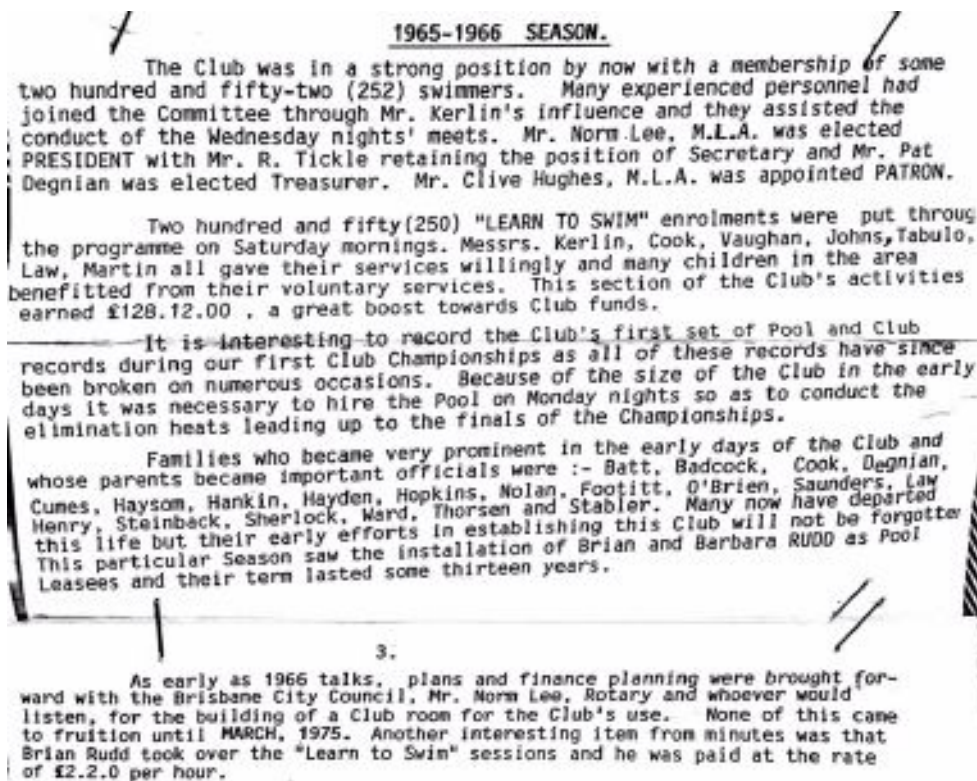
